Congress Awards

The Wim de Ruiter Delft Plate

Awarded for the most outstanding scientific technical display or workshop. Mr Wim de Ruiter, a commercial laboratory owner from Ridderkirk near Rotterdam, provided a maxillofacial prosthetics service for the Rotterdam area, and donated this award in 1985.

The Mount Vernon Award

Awarded for the most outstanding lecture. Designed and fabricated by Chief Maxillofacial Prosthetist & Technologist John Haywarde at Mount Vernon Hospital this award was first presented at the 1981 IMPT congress held at Brunel University, London.

The President's Award

Awarded for the most outstanding artistic contribution to maxillofacial prosthetics. This award was donated in 1983 by Maurice Jones at the IMPT International Congress held at The Royal College of Surgeons.

The Kidd Award

Awarded for the most outstanding contribution to implant technology. This award was donated by Mr Norman Kidd who began making sub-periosteal implants in 1956 and, upon his retirement, instigated the Kidd Award Plaque in 1997.

The Institute Award

Awarded for the best first time lecture presentation.
